



New Hamburg Skating Club/New Hamburg Power COVID -19 Policies/Protocols—August 29, 2021

1. NHSC/NHP will supply Education Resources on new safety and hygiene protocols to it's membership.
2. NHSC/NHP will implement a Covid-19 Response Plan.
3. Communication of all Covid -19 information will be done through e-mail and posted on our website.
4. A signed Waiver form must be signed by each participant prior to participation in any club activity.
5. All individuals taking part in club activities must self-screen in accordance with current public health guidelines before each training session.
6. The front doors of the Wilmot Recreation Complex are unlocked this year. When you enter the facility, all skaters will head to the Skating Club table, or coach, to screen in. Parents are asked to use the Township of Wilmot online screening tool, or the paper copies that will be at our NHSC/NHP table.
7. There will be no entrance to the dressing rooms until 15 minutes before the scheduled session. Skaters must vacate the dressing rooms within 15 minutes from their session finishing.
8. Screening will be done on a daily basis on-site before participation in any club activities.
9. The NHSC/NHP will track all skaters, coaches participation in club activities on a daily basis. This will be recorded and used for contract tracing.
10. As of September 7, 2021, the NHSC/NHP will be able to return to normal maximum numbers of skaters on the ice for our programming. This will be updated as the government updates their policies.
11. Parents will drop off skaters at the rink in the parking lot, or the designated 'drop off' locations. **No drop off zone in front of doors.**
12. Skaters will use appropriate entrance and exit doors to the facility.
13. Only parents/guardians and siblings of NHSC/NHP members are to enter the facility to watch a session at this time. We are working to keep the number of spectators in the facility to a minimum to help slow the spread. All parents/guardians will be able to sit in the stands or can stay in the lobby area and MUST social distance from all others.
14. Participants will wash/sanitize hands upon entry to the facility.
15. Skaters must wear a face mask while in facility until on the ice.
16. Coaches must wear a face mask while in facility until on the ice.
17. Skaters must arrive to the facility in their athletic wear.
18. Personal items must be left in vehicle. Each skater must use own water bottle, tissue box, etc.
19. All winter gloves should be washed on a daily basis.
20. Skaters must have closed containers to take home any waste (tissues, etc) from the facility. All waste must be disposed of at home.

21. Coaches will be responsible for all injuries on the ice. They will have masks/shields readily available to be able to do close contact. All injuries will be reported immediately to Township.
22. Coaches may now physically assist skaters in learning all skating skills from learning to get up from the ice, to working on advanced figure skating skills.
