Skaters must have strong basic forward and backward skating skills to register in our power skating programs. Full hockey/ringette equipment is required, including stick.

Ice times are scheduled based on enrolment in prior years and are subject to change based on final enrolment numbers. A program may be cancelled if there is not sufficient demand to ensure viability of the program.

The NHSC/NHP cannot guarantee make up sessions for cancelled sessions due to inclement weather or facility issues.

PROGRAMS:

POWER 1

Ages 5 – 9 years

(House/Local League, select, md, b/bb, ds, b, a)

Designed to teach the skating fundamentals needed to improve speed, quickness, and overall skating agility. Fundamental techniques are taught correctly from the start, allowing skaters to develop their skills slowly and increase speed as the skill is mastered.

POWER 2

Ages 10 years and older

(House/Local League, select, md, b/bb, a/aa, aaa, ds, c/b, bb), rep. players, or at the discretion of NHP Staff

Designed to further skating fundamentals and continue to improve speed, quickness, and overall skating agility.
